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1. General Information

i. What is TelemedEdu?

2. Launching Website/Installing mobile application:

i. Launching Website:

Using any browser, Type <https://www.telemededu.org> on the address bar and hit enter. Note that all browsers are supported.

3. Registration process

As mentioned earlier in this document, the organization intended to use the services of TelemedEdu have to go through a registration process. Complete the registration process by following the below steps.

- i. Click the link <https://www.telemededu.org/Login/Registration>
- ii. Scroll down to enter the information in all the fields.



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5. Roles

i. Signing Authority:

This is the key role that performs the registration process at <https://www.telemededu.org> .

- a. Register at <https://www.telemededu.org>
- b. Login with the UserID and Password and make payment.
- c. Sign the agreement that is received as part of registration process and send it to contact@telemededu.org
- d. Create/register Supervisor who is responsible to handle the account.
- e. Look at users list and manage them.

ii. Supervisor:

- a. Create medical resident/physician accounts.

- b. Create supervisor accounts incase of people with similar roles exist in the organization.
- c. Look and manage medical resident/physician accounts.

iii. Medical Resident/Physician:

- a. Login to <https://www.telemededu.org>
- b. Create resident accounts as needed.


6. How it works:
